Advice & Safety

Unpack and inspect all the contents.

We recommend that two people assemble this product.


Warning: For safe operation and continued high performance from this product, inspection and maintenance must be performed before each use. Do not use this product if there are any missing, damaged or malfunctioning parts.

This net is to be used for golf driving practice only, it is not a toy.

Never position the net so that damage could occur to background people or objects (windows, pets etc.) should the ball miss the net.

Never allow anyone to stand behind the net.

Always use the same precautions as when playing golf.



Unpack and layout the contents. Layout the net as shown above, taking note of the pole sleeves.

Take both (elasticated) frame poles and assemble to their full lengths.

Thread one of the frame poles through the pole 'loops' at corner A1, through the pole sleeves and out through the pole 'loops' at corner A2.


Repeat this using the second frame pole. Thread the frame pole through the pole 'loops' at corner B1, through the pole sleeves and out through the pole 'loops' at corner B2.

Step 2

Two people are required to complete this step.

Taking hold of the net at corner A1, insert the circlet pin into the metal end of the frame pole (fig 2 - corner B1 is shown). Take the other end of the same pole, flex the pole and insert the circlet pin as before at corner A2. Make sure that both pole sleeves can slide freely on the pole.


Repeat the above procedure from corner B1 (shown) to B2.



Step 3

At the top of the net (where the poles cross) attach the net to the poles using the 'Velcro' straps

Spread the four corners of the net out squarely and secure to the ground using a ground peg at each corner.



Step 4

Attach the 'target' panel to the back wall of the net as shown using the ties and 'Velcro' straps.
