What they say: Sureshot GPS provides distances from and to anywhere on the golf course. Golfers can record how far they hit each club and the system will make a recommendation on which club to use based on recorded data. During your first year's subscription you can download as many courses as you want from the thousands mapped across Europe – the system holds up to 10 in its memory. Sureshot also allows you to keep scores, and once you've finished, built-in analysis software means you can dissect your round to pinpoint your own strengths and weaknesses.

How it works: You download mapped courses (or you can map your own) from the Sureshot database online. Two screen views make it easy to recognise distances to mapped points (bunkers, water hazards, trees and banks), and once you are on the fairway, the screen shows distances to the front and back

of the green as well as the centre, making club selection lot easier. Annual subscription after the first year costs about £30.

What we think:

Uploading software and downloading courses takes time, but get through the initial frustration and your perseverance is rewarded. The Sureshot shows you where everything

is located and how far you need to hit shots to carry obstacles and hazards. Knowing the centre of the 1st green at your local course is 18.8 miles from your back garden might not be too useful, but it's handy to have access to the same information when you've sliced a drive on to the 18th from the 1st! All in all, a decent system.
